

Sponsor a scholarship place

The Global Street Paper Summit 2026 will take place for three days between the 1 to 3 September in Glasgow.

The summit invites street paper staff - as social entrepreneurs - together to meet in person, share knowledge and ideas, and think through the latest innovations to tackle poverty and homelessness.

Previous summits have had a huge impact on participants, who return to their home countries with new ideas, contacts and knowhow. With the cost of living crisis increasing poverty and homelessness across the world, this has never been more important.

However, a number of street papers, often working in the most marginalised communities around the world, can only attend through scholarships, paid for by sponsorship.

Why become a sponsor?

As well as enabling street papers in the most marginalised communities to benefit from the summit, all scholarship delegates will provide written or video testimonies, outlining the impact of attending the summit. These will be posted on social media alongside the details of your organisation, and shared with you for you to use in your PR activity.

Sponsorship cost

Sponsoring a scholarship costs £1,500, covering the cost of a ticket to the summit and contributing to travel costs.
